# An essential meeting for leaders in decarbonization

To all our colleagues in the Canadian industrial sectors:

Many thanks for joining us in Toronto for the second iteration of Decarb Connect Canada! 160+ attendees joined us over the three day event and we loved the continued evidence of industry's determination to future proof operations in Canada by both reducing co2 and increasing waste valorization.

Being in Canada as the US election took place was fascinating. We heard firsthand what some of the US's longest standing industrial and energy partners thought about the changes ahead; the consensus was that much of the IRA funding that has been deployed would stay in place – but that there were concerns about the impact of tariffs on the longstanding export of energy and critical products from north to south... lots to look out for as 2025 unfolds.

With Canada awaiting its own general election date, some of the offline discussion was about the extent to which the general public's concerns about prices and jobs might affect a new administration's policy in support of climate projects and plans.

It is clear that co2 management is needed to help Canadian industry remain competitive in other international markets – but we also all know that populations can both want and see urgency in climate issues whilst at the same time not understand the permitting and investment necessities that would be required to enact them. A number of the panels and speakers called on all of us in the decarbonization



landscape rethink how we engage with communities to show them the jobs, export potential, community as well as climate benefits of co2 work.

With policy in mind, we were proud to welcome keynote speakers Hon. Graydon Smith, Minister of Natural Resources for Ontario, and Hon. Brian Jean, Minister of Energy & Minerals for Alberta. We also welcomed Patrick Hum, DG of Clean Technology and Clean Growth for the Government of Canada to the discussions along with many colleagues from across government departments. Thank you to all the govt attendees and speakers for your willingness to engage across the event and to listen to what industry needs.

Across the event we saw high levels of engagement with the industrialled sessions including how to :

- Unlock the potential for CCS in industry
- Create and sell low carbon products
- Roll out bio energy and ccs projects
- Engage employees and stakeholders
- Scale up after a successful pilot
- Electrify with the right renewables and storage infro/tech
- Bring innovation and disruptive technology to foundation/traditional industries

Other sessions on tackling CBAM reporting, the timeline much-needed grid infrastructure, hydrogen market evolution and many other issues all saw good Q&A sessions .. so many questions from all our attendees – thank you!


